- Your initial payment includes £50 administration fee and £75 deposit. This is **non-refundable**.
- The balance should be paid **ten weeks before departure**.
- Where a booking is agreed by Christians Aware less than ten weeks before departure, full payment is required.
- Payment does not include travel to and from the island.

Travel Insurance

- Photocopy of worldwide comprehensive insurance to be sent to Christians Aware office, within 28 days of booking.
- Any claims (e.g. illness) to be made by participants, not Christians Aware.

Pilgrimage to the Isle of Wight

A pilgrimage on this idyllic island. Time to reflect, to walk, to enjoy good food and fellowship, and to enjoy spiritual encouragement from those in the local community

The pilgrimage will be an opportunity to recharge your batteries and to stay at a great walking hotel with amazing views right on the cliff top in Freshwater Bay.

Make your own way to Yarmouth¹ or travel with the minibus (pick up points to be arranged and this cost will be extra), arriving on Monday afternoon. We will all get together for the evening meal, before walking down to St. Agnes, the island's thatched church, where we will be welcomed by locals from CTWW. We will share a short time of worship followed by a cuppa.

CTWW comprises eleven local churches of five denominations. The churches work closely together in various ministries, including the Holiday Bible Club, the West Wight Churches Youth Project and visiting residential homes, to name but a few. And folk worship regularly together.

CTWW folk look forward to welcoming the pilgrims from Christians Aware.

On Tuesday we hope to go to Carisbrooke Castle to be greeted by clergy, then on Wednesday to Whippingham Church, with an opportunity to visit Osborne House or Quarr Abbey, possibly by local bus. Osborne House is part of English Heritage and there is a fee for non-members.

Thursday will be a free day for exploration. Lots of ideas will be provided including walking to Alum Bay. There may also be an afternoon opportunity to learn about prison ministry on the island.

Transport costs on the island will be in addition to the quoted costs and will be dependent on size of the group.

You are asked to reserve your place with Christians Aware as soon as possible as the hotel is already filling up fast.

The cost of the visit is £430. This includes full board (packed lunches), donations, and administration. A premier room with sea view is £5 extra per night. Single supplement is £8 per person per night.

Please bring walking shoes or boots and full waterproofs.
